Spring is here and the weather started getting good around March 21st. Let's hope it stays this mild for the next few months.

There is a lot going on in April. So, hold onto your Scotty Cameron.

Besides Bogey Bunch, Chip & Chatter & the Seniors getting ready to tee off we have:

The **"Masters Proxy"**, pick your Partner on Saturday the 10th. Anyone can enter and here is how it works. Message from our Golf Course Superin-



CCC Members,

I think it is safe to say that 2021 is officially underway here at CCC. As always, this early spring period has had its fair share of temperature and precipitation swings, however looking back thus far it has been fairly forgiving. Let's all hope that Mother Nature treats us well and after the melancholy of winter we can all enjoy some much needed sunlight.

Spring is a very busy time for the golf course maintenance department as we wrap up projects from late winter, reintroduce amenities to the golf course, and oh yeah, actually mow grass again! There is still a good bit of cleanup to perform from the natural mess that is produced from months of sticks, pine cones, and a myriad of other debris that has been spread around the golf course. We have been working through our annual cleaning out of stump holes and to date have about 10 or so left. This process has been more challenging this year as we are facing an issue with a hydraulic leak on our backhoe loader, forcing more hand digging and hauling of debris with only carts. As usual we will be prepping the majority of these areas for sod while some others will just be seeded, most likely due to the location and growing environment. As of today, Friday, all fine turf surfaces have received at least their first mow, with fairways being the final piece. Green color is rapidly returning across the property with the wet and warm stretch that we are in, especially on the lower holes. The floods that we receive are certainly much more of a headache than anything else, but I suppose if you were to find a silver lining in them it would be the expeditious color and growth.



As you can see on the bottom, our 15th hole has a much deeper

and consistent green color right now than number 18, depicted above.

Spring aerification is in the books, as well as another successful contracted Dryject event. This year we were presented with a slight problem, being that the lows were very cold in the nights leading up to the 15th. Our delay Monday morning was not due to frost, but instead the fact that the very tops of the greens had frozen again. All in all no complaints about the weather though, as we had fantastic conditions yet again with a cold, but mostly clear and breezy day. First we pulled a small ¼" plug with our machines and simply blew the greens off instead of needing to pick them up. Then a light to moderate amount of sand was applied to the greens. Next step was the Dryject process, which as a reminder, is a machine that utilizes our irrigation water to inject dry sand into the rootzone. These channels vary in shape, with most having a healthy fat column to start and as it moves further down takes on more of a shattered pattern. After multiple efforts of brushing and rolling the greens were in good shape, even though their appearance may have said otherwise. Due to the physiological nature of these plants as well as the ever shifting weather, we will not be mowing or rolling every single day. That means there may be some inconsistency as we heal in, but sitting 10 days out from the process I am very happy with what we are seeing thus far.


Admittedly the greens are on a bit of a steroid package right now to assist in

healing, however both the color and growth are also both linked to the positive

weather pattern that we have been enjoying. Mowing and rolling should help

to work out what I would refer to as the "wild" growth habit much of the turf

is currently displaying.



By the time the next article comes out it is going to be a completely different world out on the course, and in a good way. Here's to another fantastic golf season!!





Mini-Team- Monday, Wednesday, Friday- 11:30 am- 12:00 pm


There will be 5 meets- 2 home and 3 away. Meets are typically Tuesday and Thursday at noon- but we may schedule an evening meet.



Important announcement

In follow up to last evening's announcement pertaining to food minimums, this last moment addition to the Crier was inserted just prior to publication. On the following two pages are the calendar and normal April hours of operation that we had completely planned to run with beginning April 1st, which entailed going back to a full six day slate of open F&B hours. Though we fully intend to honor that as soon as is practical, for the immediate short term future we will need to maintain running limited hours and offerings on Tuesdays and Wednesdays due to shortage of kitchen staff. We thank you for, and ask your continued patience and consideration while we navigate through this situation

We will prepare a series of selections that allow for ease of preparation and no A'la Minute cooking. This will be offering more of a deli type fare consisting of a series of soups, sandwiches, wraps, and salads that do not require immediate cooking. Operating like this will allow for Kyrsten to tend to all the administrative kitchen functions in addition to the large prep component normally spread amongst 3– 4 additional cooks. I will continue to assist as available, as will a few of our Front of House staff who have been pulling together, well, during this unusual labor market.

Until we are able to rebuild a kitchen staff, we will be open from 11:00 am through 7:00 pm on Tuesdays and Wednesdays serving Deli Styled foods that do not require immediate cooking. We will add back in the limited hot components that we have served for the past couple of weeks on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 11:00 am through 8:00 pm; and Sunday from 11:00 am through 4:00 pm.

We truly apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and plan to be up and running better than ever in the near future. If anyone has any questions or observations, please contact me or House Committee Chair, Jeremy Sauv , contact info available in roster.



Please find enclosed in this letter information on our package offerings for 2021. Please indicate what packages you would like on the next page and fax or mail it into us at the golf shop before February 25th, 2021. **This year, you may also sign up for the Hole in One Club as well as the Ringer Tournament right on your package signup form.** You may still sign up for these events in the Pro Shop before they begin as well. This letter is also available to download on the Club Website at www.carlislecountryclub.com. If you have any questions on this please do not hesitate to call us in the golf shop at (717) 243-6866.

A package of 20 cart rides is available to you for \$360.00 plus tax. On our books we break this down as 40 nine hole rides should you wish to ride just nine holes. A normal 18-hole cart fee will be \$21.00 plus tax in 2021. Purchasing a package will save you \$3.00 per ride or a total of \$60.00 for twenty rides. Cart packages can be used within a family or when bringing guests to the club. In 2021, you will also have the option of purchasing a season unlimited pass which enables you to take a cart whenever you want for as many holes as you want for the entire season. The price for this is \$640.00 plus tax for one person and \$945.00 plus tax for two people.

Range packages for 2021 are unchanged and available as follows. A family range package is available for \$200.00 and a single range package is available for \$150.00. Range packages allow you unlimited practice balls on the warm-up range and lower range. We no longer use small, medium and large buckets on the range as the practice balls will be out on the range for you whenever it is open. If you do not purchase a range package there will be a \$5.00 "Range Usage" fee per person per day should you wish to use the range for a warm up or a practice session. Weather permitting the practice facilities will be open from April through November in 2021.

Bag storage fees for 2021 are \$100.00. Collapsible cart storage is available at a rate of \$100.00 also. Please remember that collapsible carts must be folded up, fit within and be stored in a club/bag storage space in the bag room. If your pushcart does not fit within a bag storage space you will not be able to store it here without a power cart storage space.

Power cart storage in the bag room is currently full, with a waitlist. The price for power cart storage is \$250.00. Members who have this service have been contacted to see if they want to continue it in 2021. If you are interested in being put on the waitlist for this service, please call us in the Pro Shop.
